**JooHee Yoon** is an illustrator and printmaker who divides her time between New York and Rhode Island. This is her second picture book.





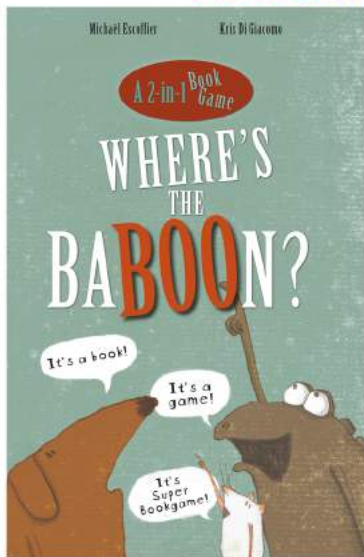
